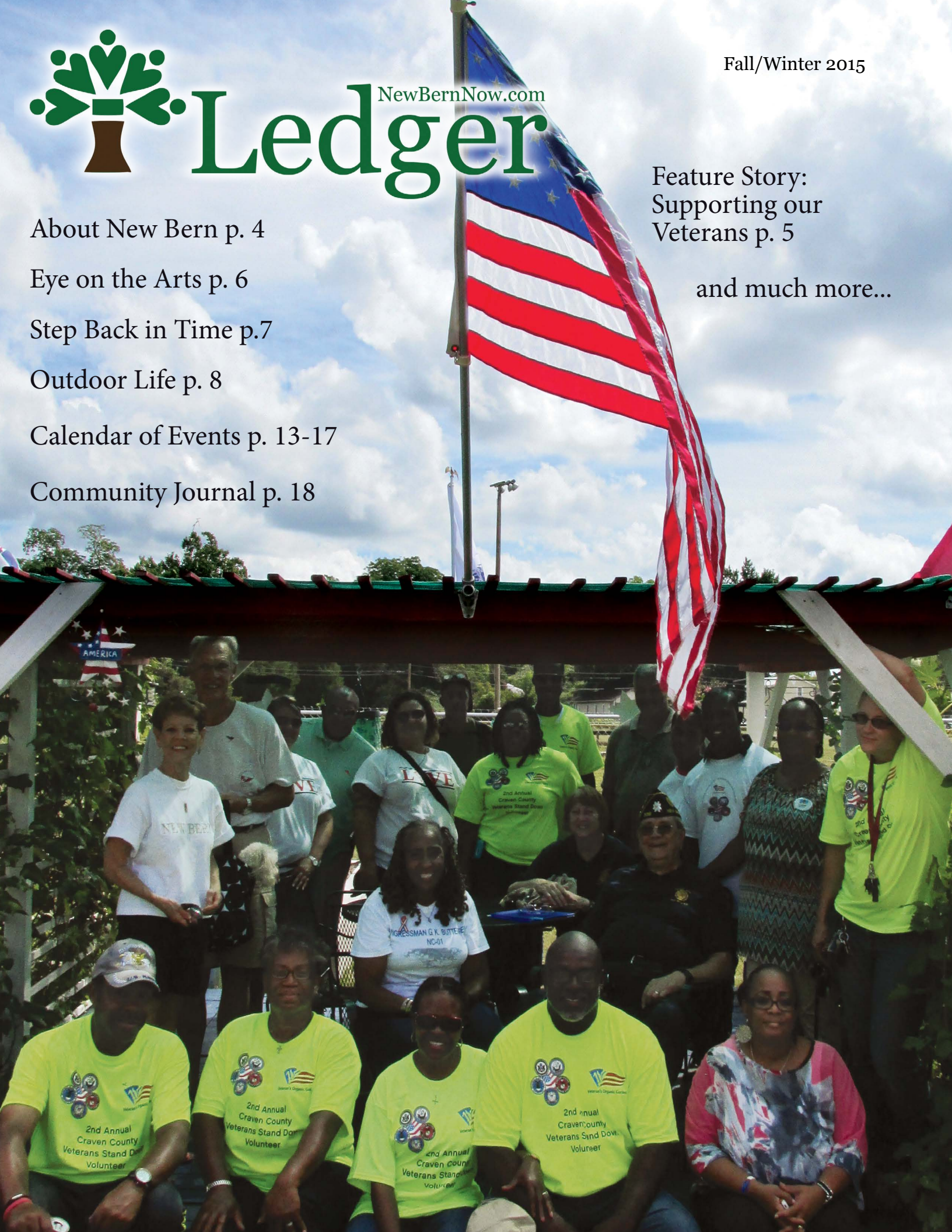

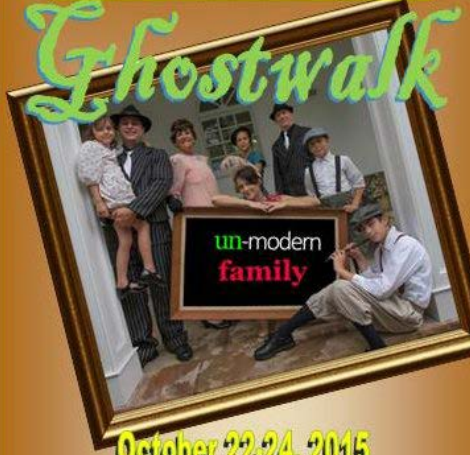

When someone says, "Thank you for your service", I appreciate their acknowledgement, but I consider myself very privileged for all of the training, traveling, life experiences, and friends I met along the way. Please thank the veterans who have been physically and emotionally damaged for the rest of their lives... they should be the ones being honored for the sacrifices they made while serving our Country

Living in New Bern and Eastern NC, some people may not even realize that we have homeless veterans living amongst us. We also have neighbors who suffer every day and some of them spend most of their time homebound because of the aftermath of what they've been through.

Our community is very fortunate to have some terrific organizations that serve veterans. The first one that comes to mind is the Veterans Employment Base Camp and Organic Garden (VEBCOG) founded by Lovay Wallace-Singleton. Lovay and her team are trying their best to help homeless veterans and rehabilitate disabled veterans in Craven County.

The VEBCOG and NCWORKS Career Center Craven County host Craven County Stand Downs. A special Veterans outreach program that benefits Homeless Veterans in Craven, Pamlico, Jones and Carteret Counties.

"Homeless Veterans was modeled after the Stand Down concept used during the Vietnam War to provide a safe retreat for units returning from combat operations. At secure base camp areas, troops were able to take care of personal hygiene, get clean uniforms, enjoy warm meals, receive medical and dental care, send and receive mail letters, and enjoy the camaraderie of friends in a safe environment. We are expecting 150 Veterans in need of services each day." - Lovay Wallace-Singleton.

They partner with local non-profits, Veteran organizations, and businesses to provide information about readily available resources to help homeless veterans and/or those at risk of becoming homeless.

NC Works provides no cost services for career assessments, labor market information; Access to training opportunities, job fairs, and workshops; Job interview preparation; Resume and cover letter assistance; and Access to computers and free Internet service. - Gertrude Carraway, journalist, author, and philanthropist was influential in the restoration of Tryon Palace
- James Davis opened the First Printing Press in North Carolina
- Birthplace of Pepsi Cola, invented in New Bern by Caleb Bradham
- First Public School in North Carolina
- First Chartered Fire Department in North Carolina
- New Bern's Devastating Fire of 1922
- Beverly Perdue became NC's First Female Governor
- Novelist and Screenwriter, Nicholas Sparks - resident and founder of the Epiphany School
- Tommy Moore, Owner of Moore's BBQ, received the Guinness World Record for the largest open faced BBQ bun.
- Home to NFL Players George Koonce and Kevin Reddick
- Professional Basketball Player and Hall of Famer, Walt Bellamy
- Adam Warren, New York Yankees Pitcher, is from New Bern.

Do you prefer paddling? Contact the [Neuse Riverkeepers](http://www.neuseriverkeepers.com) (637-7972) and/or the [Twin Rivers Paddle Club](http://www.twinriverspaddleclub.com) (636-6606) for paddle trail maps and details about boating and fishing on the Neuse and Trent Rivers along with their tributaries. You can also rent kayaks, stand up paddleboards, bikes, and take tours with the Bear Town Adventure Co. (288-5823). Stand Up Outfitters also rents SUPs (514-0404).

A "Nature Lover's Paradise", enjoy the Croatan National Forest (NF). The forest's habitat has exotic plants like the Venus flytrap, making it the only NF with the largest carnivorous plant population. The Croatan spans approximately 160,000 acres and is located in New Bern's backyard. It's a sanctuary for black bear, deer, wild turkey, quail, coyote, beaver, porcupine, bobcat, American alligator, bald eagle, red-tailed hawk, and other wildlife you may see.

Talk to the people at the Croatan NF Ranger's Station on Hwy 70 E (638-5628). The Croatan is full of history and untamed lands!

Campers have many choices. Stay at New Bern's KOA located on Hwy 17 N in Bridgeton (800-562-3341). Visit Flanner's Beach Campground or Neuse River Campground which are run by the Croatan National Forest. Brice's Creek also has a small primitive campground.

Join cyclists at Flythe's Bike Shop, 2411 Trent Rd, as Flythe's leads bike rides around town (638-1544). You can also rent bike's from them at the Galley Stores, 300 E. Front St. Atomic Cycles also leads rides around town. Visit them at 504 S. Front St. (633-2242).

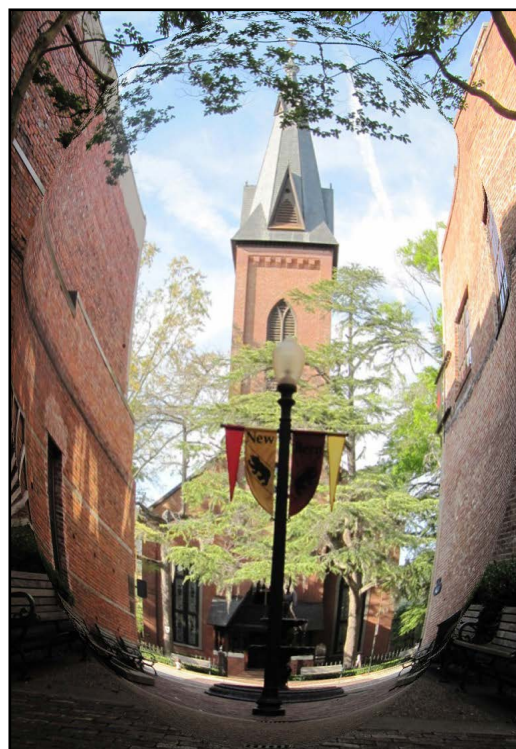

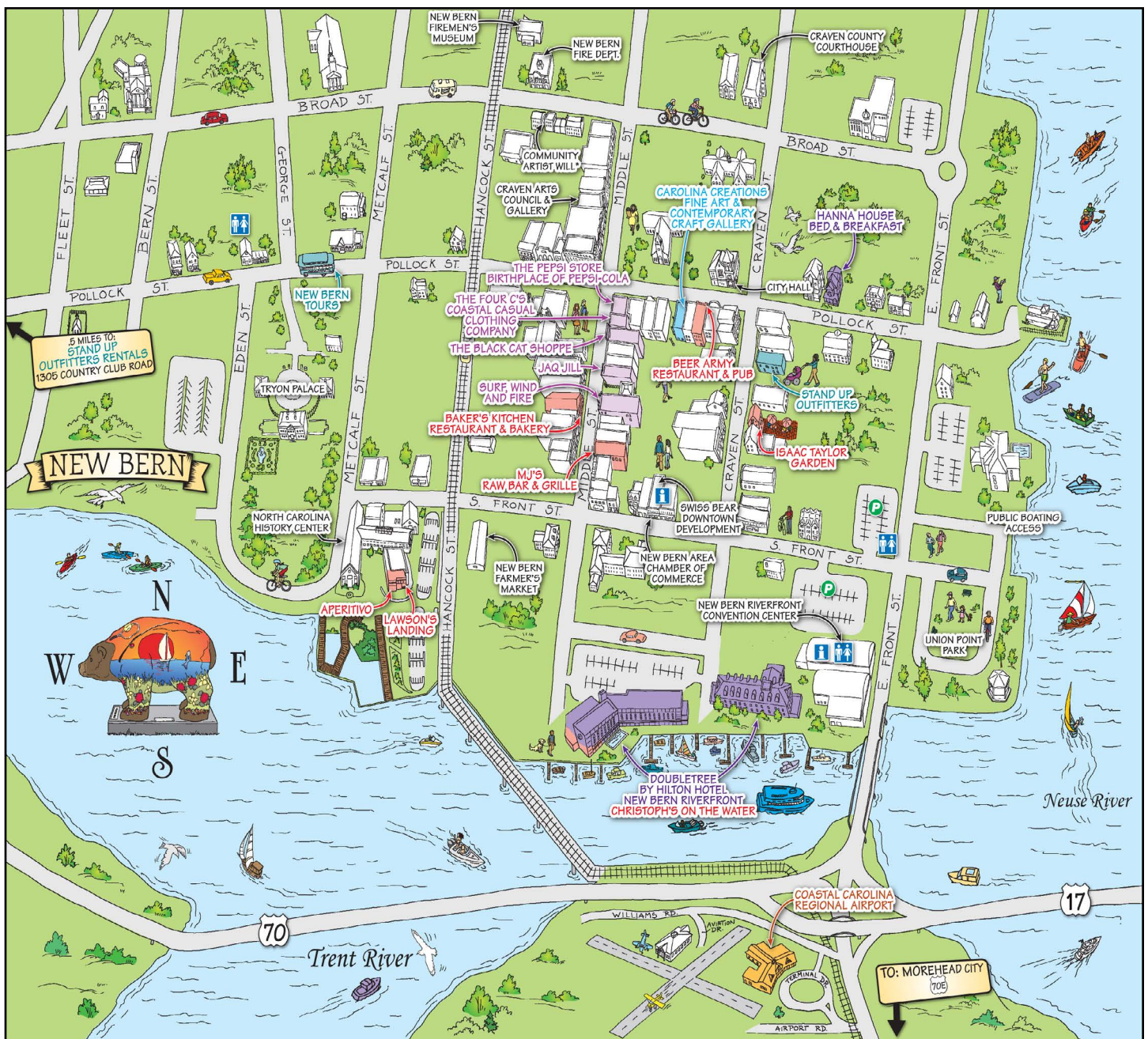
